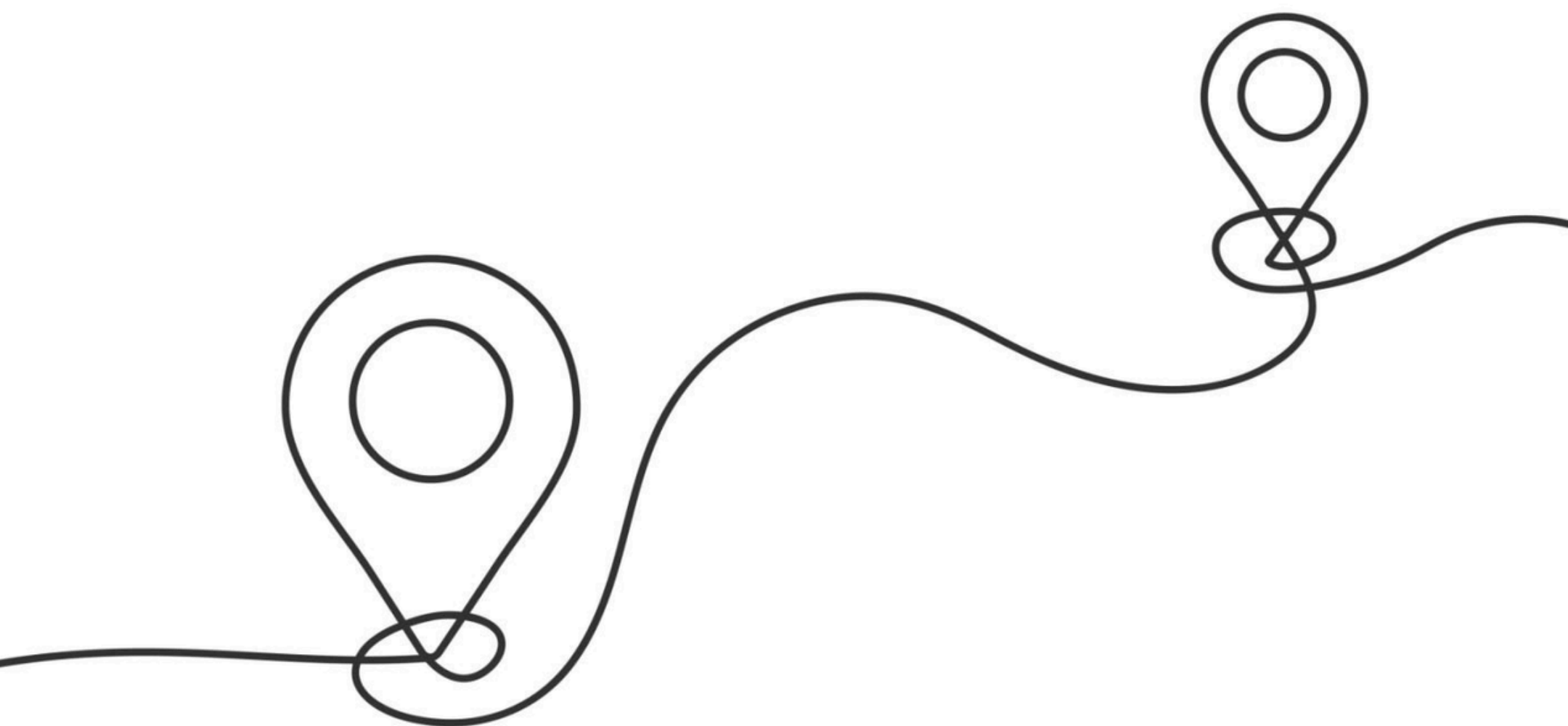

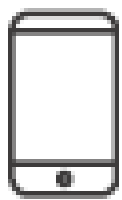

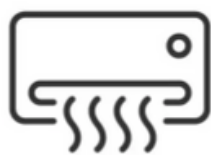
THINKS TO KNOW

Tap Water



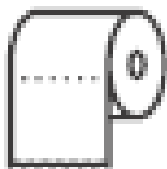
Please note that tap water is not drinkable. We recommend purchasing bottled water during your stay.

Food animals



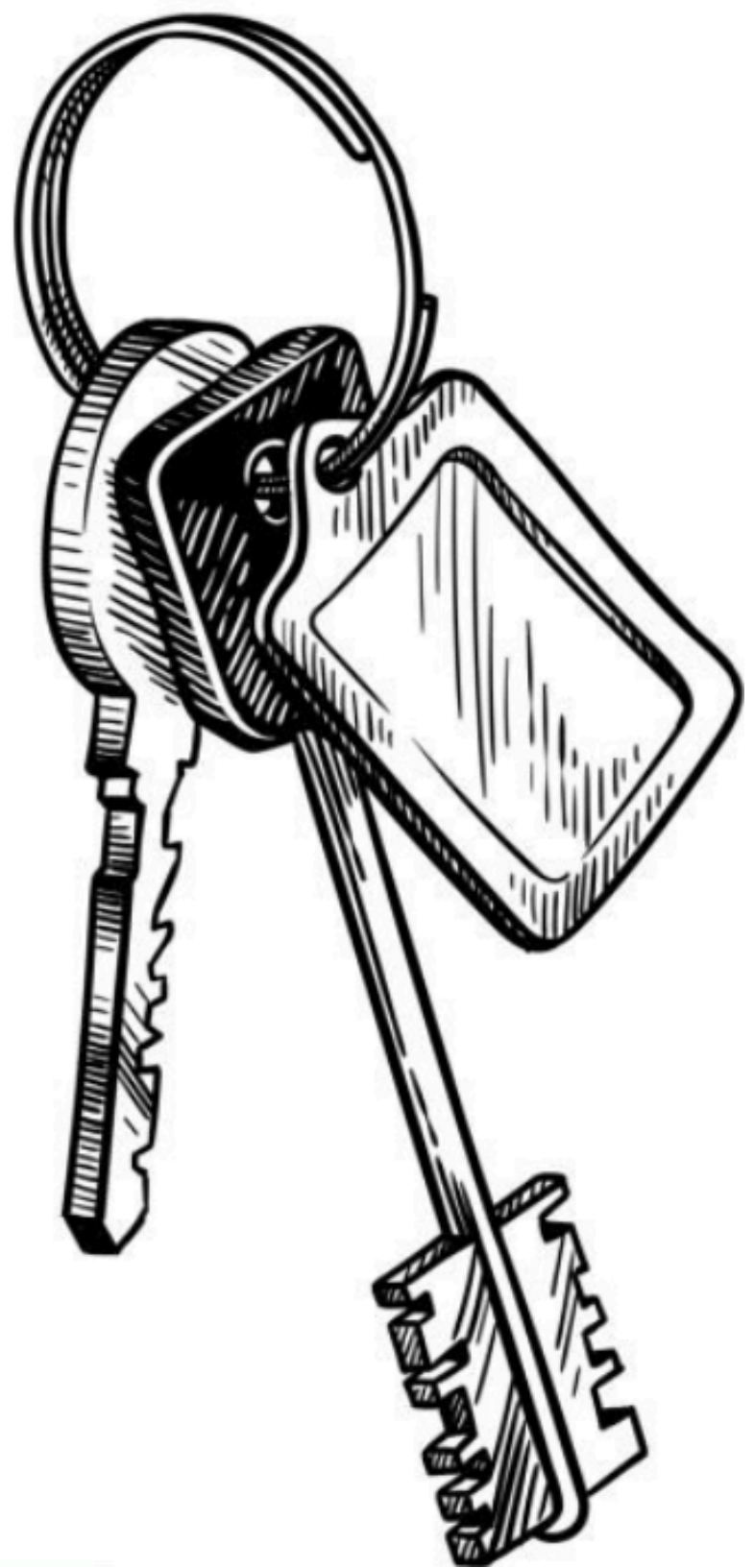
Please, don't feed the animals. They have a restricted diet to their needs.

SENHORA DA BOA NOVA

The Sanctuary of Nossa Senhora da Assunção da Boa Nova is a Gothic fortress-church and a rare example of Portuguese fortress architecture. It remains nearly intact to this day and was classified as a National Monument in 1910.

PLACES TO VISIT

VILA VIÇOSA

One of the most historically rich towns in the Alentejo yet to be fully explored.

ÉVORA

Designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site, this city is best explored by strolling through the narrow streets of its walled historic center.

JUROMENHA

Notable for its medieval fortress, with a privileged location offering views of the neighboring country.

ELVAS

Near the border, Elvas is the most important fortified city in Europe.

ARRAIOLOS

The Alentejan town best known for its creation of Arraiolos rugs.

BEACH AZENHAS D'EI REY

In the municipality of Alandroal in Montes Juntos, you will have the opportunity to enjoy the river beach, participate in water activities, and dine at a restaurant that serves regional dishes, all while appreciating the surrounding natural beauty.

LUCEFECIT RIVER

Since pre-Roman times, this has been a sacred place where the first peoples inhabiting what is now Portuguese territory worshiped their deities.

MONSARAZ

This medieval village in Alentejo offers views of the Alqueva Dam and is perfect for exploring local shops and wandering its historic streets.

ESTREMOZ

Known as the ‘white city’ and for its strategic location at the very heart of the Alentejo region.
